Tena Koutou Parents, Caregivers and Whanau,

Alert Level 2 Rules:

- Please stay home if you are unwell. **School is open for instruction therefore students who are not sick must be attending.**
- Safe hygiene practices must be followed when at school - washing hands regularly, coughing etiquette and distancing when possible.
- **No one is permitted on to school grounds** with the exception of students and staff. **All visitors**, including parents, caregivers and whanau, must check in at the office on arrival.
- When dropping off or collecting children, please wait in your vehicle or if on foot, waiting at the front entry of the school maintaining a safe distance from others.
- If you have any concerns we encourage you to contact the office.

Postponements/Cancellations.

All external sports and activities are suspended during Alert Level 2. That means no students will attend events outside of school during this time. Once we are in Alert Level 1, further detailed information will be provided. Internal activities will still operate however strict procedures will be in place for any visitors who will be providing services for learning support which also includes our Passion Hour. Again, only those individuals and groups providing support will be given access to school grounds.

STUDENT LED CONFERENCES (SLCs)

These are scheduled to take place on **Friday 11 September.**

A detailed notice has been sent home with instructions for you to make bookings online with your child's teacher and procedures of the SLCs. Remember, as with the last SLCs, **school will not be open for instruction** so alternative arrangements will need to be made for your child on this day however **they must attend the appointment with you, in school uniform.** Because of minimal numbers and safe procedures, we are able to run SLC's during Level 1 or 2.

Book School Interviews Online

Parent-teacher interviews will be held at the following times:

- 8:30am – 3.15pm Friday 11th September 2020

To book your interviews, go to www.schoolinterviews.co.nz/code in your browser, and enter the event code **s8zjr**. Then follow these three simple steps:



First enter your name, your student's name, and your email address.

If you need to book for more than one student, change the "Book for x students" setting, and enter the other student's name.



On the next page, pick the teachers you want to meet.

First select the subject, then choose from the list of teachers.



Then you'll see a timetable showing when your chosen teachers are available. Simply click on the times that suit you.

When you have finished, your interview timetable will be emailed to you. And you can return to the site and enter the event code **s8zjr** again to change or cancel your interviews.
